Every year TTC and CMC sponsor the essay contest and the winner for an all-expense paid trip of a lifetime for a high school junior who receives local phone service from the companies. The companies support youth in additional ways including offering over \$10,000 in scholarships, sponsoring the Montana High School Academic Challenge and other academic programs and by purchasing 4-H animals at county fairs.
